ORAL QUESTION

1. By Mr. Taberannang Timeon MP (Tab North)

OQ6. E kona te Tautaeaka ni waekoa ni karekea onean mwin ana solar water pump te kaawa ae Tekabuibui i Tabiteuea Meang?

Translation/Rairana

Could Government urgently provide a replacement for the solar water pump for the village of Tekabuibui, Tabiteuea North?

OQ7. E kona te Tautaeaka ni manga rinanoan ana babaire ibukin katokan irakia aoraki n rin n te onaoraki ao man kariaia bwa temanna man te utu e na ira te aoraki are e bon kakaiakaki aorakina?

Translation/Rairana

Could Government revisit its decision to stop caretakers from accompanying sick patients and allow in certain cases, especially for very sick people to have someone from the family, accompany the patients?

2. By Mr. Bonteman Tabera MP (Nonouti)

OQ13. A rangi ni kakaitau kaain Nonouti nakon te Tautaeaka ibukin rakan boon te takakataka. E kona te Tautaeaka ni ibuobuoki ni karekei bwaai ni mwakuri, n aron te mitin, ibukin kaitiakan buakonikai ao kenakin niibwa ibukin unikan te ni iaon Nonouti?

Translation/Rairana

The People in Nonouti wish to thank the Government for the increase in the price of copra. Could the Government assist in providing the working tools, like machineries for clearing the bushes and for digging the pits for the planting of coconut trees in Nonouti?

Translation/Rairana

The place where the communication tower for the mobile telephone in Nonouti would be erected has been prepared but the mobile telephone still remains to be connected to Nonouti. Could the Minister responsible inform this House when the mobile telephone would be installed in Nonouti?

OQ15. E kona te Minita are tabena ni iangoa kenakin raawa ibukin roron kaibuke ao riki kaibuke ake a bwaabwaka taboia i Taboiaki ao i Temwanoku ibukin kabebetean anaakin te takataka ao kabwakaan kaako?

Translation/Rairana

Could the Minister responsible consider digging passages for ships especially landing crafts at Taboiaki and Temanoku to assist with the offloading of cargoes and the loading of copra?
