ORAL QUESTIONS

1. **By Hon. Dr. Kautu Tenaua MP (Abaiang)**

OQ1. E teimatoa Nuotaea iaon Abaiang n rotaki ni kangangan reken te ran ae itiaki ibukin te mooi ma te amwarake. Tera ngkai ae e a tia ni karaoia te Tautaeka ni kaitara te kanganga aei?

Translation/Rairana

Nuotaea community continue to experience difficulties in getting potable water for human consumption in the village. Can I ask the Minister concerned what action has been taken to help the Nuotaea community?

2. **By Hon. David Christopher MP (Rabi)**

OQ2. Iai kainnanaan te taura te Solar bwa e na kaotaa nanon te boat harbor are i Banaba. E a bon tia naba n tabekaki te titiraki aei inanon taai aika a nako.

E kona te Tautaeka n nora riain ao ienikurian katiaan te karikirake aei?

Translation/Rairana

There is a need for solar to light up the boat harbor on Banaba. This question has been raised here previously. Could Government kindly consider the need and hasten completion of this project?

OQ3. E kona te Minita are tabena ni kaongoraea te Auti aio bwa e a toki iaa ngkai ana karikirake Banaba are karaoan te marae ni wanikiba?

Translation/Rairana

Could the Honourable Minsiter responsible kindly inform this House the latest update on the construction of the airport in Banaba?

3. By Hon. England Iuta MP (Beru)

OQ4. Ni boowin te Auti n Aokati ae nako, ao I mwemweka au titiraki bwa te Tautaeka e butiaki bwa e na kawenea imatan te Auti te beeba are e na kaota mwaitin te kabane mwane ni mwamwanagaia ana Minita, ma kainnabaia nako tinaniku inanon te ririki aio? E ngae ngke e taekinna te Beretitenti bwa e na katauraoa te beeba anne ao bon akea ae e a tia n wene imatan te Auti aei ni karokoa ngkai.

Nna manga butia riki te Beretitenti ae rine, bwa e konaa inanon boowin te Auti ngkai ni kawenea te beeba anne, ni kaota mwin mwamwanangaia ana Minita, ma kainnaibaia ni karokoa tokin Nobemba 2017?

Translation/Rairana

In the last meeting of Parliament in August, I raised a question to Government to provide Parliament a list of the expenses and external travels of Ministers, and their spouses, undertaken this year? Despite te Beretitenti saying that a list was to be provided, none so far has ever been made available.

I am now asking His Excellency Te Beretitenti again if he can kindly provide a list of the expenses and external travels of Ministers, and their spouses up to November 2017?

OQ5. Iaon Beru ao a tataneiai ngkoa aoraki, ngkana a rin, ke a ofinako man onaoraki, ni kakatauraaoaki baoia. E a toki ngkai te waaki anne ao ai bon taben te aoraki kabooan baona. On Beru, the practice was that patients were usually provided transport on admittance, or, discharge from the hospitals. The practice has long

ceased and it is now the responsibility of patients to provide their own transport. Can Government consider reintroducing the practice as is the case with the ambulance services available to the people on Taiwan?

OQ7. E kona te Tautaeaka ni katea te onaoraki are e boou n te kaawa ae Nuka i Beru n aron kateitei ake a karaoaki iaon te karikirake are te Kiri-EU?

Can Government build the new clinic in Nuka Beru exactly like the ones built under the Kiri-EU project?

OQ8. E kona te Tautaeaka ni katamaroa aron bwakan te tine bwa e na katoa uoua te wiiki?

Translation/Rairana

Can Government improve copra weight in pay outs to be paid fortnightly?

OQ9. N tokin te runga ae nako ao a katokaaki n oki taan takakaro man abamakoro aika Abemama ao Kuria n te Nivanga III are kaibuken Tuvalu. Iai kariaiakakin te kaibuke aio bwa e na uofia bwatintia rinanon Kiribati?

Translation/Rairana

At the close of the last national games, contingents from the islands of Abemama and Kuria were repatriated on MV Nivanga II , the Tuvaluan Government vessel. Is this vessel licensed to operate domestically?

OQ10. E kona te Tautaeaka ni karekei fianaraita, ke te iti ae maiu man taai, nakon taian on aoraki i Beru n te aro are ana kona iai ni kamaiuaki iai mitin n bwain aoraki ake a maiu man te iti?

Translation/Rairana

Can Government provide generators, or suitable solar power systems, for clinics on Beru for use for medical equipment that need electricity?

4. By Hon. Kaure Babo MP (Maiana)

OQ11. Uoua boono i Maiana bwa teuana i Tekaranga ma Tematantongo ao are i tabon Bubutei nakoaiaki aika ana karika te kanganga nakon te maiu, kaai n amarake, tarikan manibwa ngkana aki kibaraki iroun te Tautaeka ae. I a kan bubutia te Minita are tabena ngkana e na kona ni karaoa te bono are i Tekaranga ma Tematantongo n karaoa bonotan te causeway ae are e na tuuka rinin taari n tain te oonia ao man kariaia tiinakon te ran ngkana e mwaiti te karau kanga te tunga. Ibukin te bono are i Bubutei, te kanganga bon rietatana bwa e bon rinano ao n te oonia ae nako ao e bon tao iaon naba te bono.

Translation/Rairana

The two causeways at Maiana, one at Tekaranga and Temantantongo and the second at Bubutei southwards putting at risk life, food crops, salinity of the wells, when not attended to by this Government. I would like to request the responsible Minister to assist on this matter at Tekaranga and Tematantongo to fix the “lid” which will not allow the in-flow of sea water at high tide and at the same time can when the need arises to allow the over flow through this “gate” to stabilize the water-level. As for the causeway at Bubutei , the issue is the height of the bono which will stop the over-wash of the rip-tide during high tide. The recent past high tide over-washed even though it was not the highest.
