### ***Translation/Rairana***

That this House encourages the Government to carry out on all the islands in Kiribati including the Line and Phoenix Group the screening intake test to the Nursing school, KIT, KTC as currently done by MTC and FTC. By doing so, this will give a great opportunity to all-I-Kiribati who have the potential but unable to attend such test on Tarawa due to traveling and living costs.

## **6.8 Hon. Tekiau Aretateta, MP (Tabuaeran) will move;**

### **Motion No.5**
