MOTIONS

1. By Hon. England Iuta, MP (Beru)

Motion 1

E na butiaki te Tautaeka bwa e na nora riain kaakaean buokaia aomata ake a tuai reke aia arauenti ao bitineti ake a mwarua naba aia kaako inanon aia mwakuri ao inanon karaaian kaako mai Tarawa nako abamakoro inanon tain te Covid 19.

Rairana/Translation

Government is requested to consider if it will be able to assist its employees who still have not received allowances in performing frontline security and businesses who have also lost goods during transshipment from Tarawa to the islands at the height of Covid 19.

Motion 2

E butiaki te Tautaeka bwa e na nora riain kaakaean buokaia aomata, riki taan oro ben ake a karin mwane n te KPF ao bon ake a karin mwane ngkoa n te Bangke ni kawai ae e aki kona n reke etin aia karinimwane ao bon boon mwin aia mwane ni karokoa ngkai.

Rairana/Translation

Government is requested to consider if it will be able to assist people especially KPF voluntary contributors, and those who held accounts with the previous banking operator who are now unable to trace and have access to their deposits.

Motion 3

Motion 5

That this Maneaba would request Government to consider studying and exploring ways to build wharfs at islands without lagoons such as Nikunau.
